

School Uniform Shop

Frequently Asked Questions

1. When is the Uniform Shop open?

The Uniform Shop is open every Friday during school term from 2.30pm til 3pm. If there are a lot of customers, the shop will stay open until all customers have been served. The Uniform Shop will also be open at the beginning of the year on the School Book List Collection day.

2. I cannot get to the Uniform Shop on Friday afternoon. Is there any other way to get uniforms?

Please fill out a Uniform Shop order form and take it to the Front Office with full payment. The order will be processed the following Friday and be ready to collect during the Uniform Shop opening hours. Please advise on the order form if you are unable to collect from the Uniform Shop on a Friday afternoon and alternate arrangements for collection can be made. Please note: Uniforms will not be delivered to classrooms.

3. Where can I get a Uniform Shop Order Form?

Uniform Shop Order Forms can be obtained from the Uniform Shop, the Front Office, or by visiting the West Morley Primary School Website.

4. Does the Uniform Shop sell the Harlequin Homework Folder?

No. The Harlequin Homework Folder is available through the company that organizes the school's book lists at the beginning of the year. If you wish to purchase one, please contact Ziggies Educational Supplies (9455 3717 1/180 Bannister Rd Canning Vale 6155).

5. Does the Uniform Shop sell second hand items?

Yes. We sell a range of second-hand items in the Uniform Shop. These items have been donated by families who have outgrown the items. We do our best to ensure the second-hand items for sale are in good condition. However, some items may need a wash before wearing. Each item is \$2.

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6. Does the Uniform Shop take donations?

Yes. The Uniform Shop takes donations. We place any uniform donations in the Second-Hand box to sell on at \$2/item. This money goes into the P&C Uniform Shop account and helps with purchasing the next order of brand new uniforms.

7. I've picked the wrong size! Can I return an item?

You may return an item if the item still has its tags on and has not been worn. The item will then be exchanged for the correct size.

8. When can I order a Faction T-shirt?

Faction teams are finalized in Term 2 and the shirts are ordered shortly after. Faction t-shirts are available to purchase late in Term 2 and throughout Term 3. Some shirts may also be available during the year if the previous year's stock has not sold out.

9. Do you sell the Iron-on Logo?

Yes. We have Iron-on logos available for \$2. These are ideal for turning an everyday blue, red, or green shirt into a Faction T-shirt.

10. What is the best way to wash the clothing I purchase from the Uniform Shop?

The Polo Shirts will look their best longer if you follow the instructions on the label. However, from personal experience, the Polo Shirts still look great (although slightly faded) going through the wash on a cold cycle with regular detergent and dried in direct sunlight.

11. I'm interested in volunteering. How can I help?

Volunteers are always welcome at West Morley Primary School. If you wish to volunteer, feel free to speak with any member of the P&C committee or the Front Office. Volunteers are needed for a range of school-based services such as School Banking, Playgroup, and P&C, as well as helping in the canteen, helping with busy bees and other events.

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12. Does the Uniform Shop sell the Year 6 Leavers shirts?

No. The Year 6 Leavers shirts are arranged by the Year 6 Teachers.

13. I didn't bring any cash with me today. Can I still purchase items and pay for them later?

Unfortunately, no. We can only provide uniforms if paid for by cash, cheque or Direct Deposits. All Direct Deposits are required to have a receipt number at time of purchase.

14. I've made a Direct Deposit to the School P&C Uniform account. When can I collect my items?

Once the funds have entered the P&C Uniform Shop account, the order will be processed and ready to collect on the following Friday from the Uniform Shop. Please note that if you are depositing funds from a banking institution other than Commonwealth, it can take up to two business days for the funds to reach the account.

15. What material are the polo shirts made from?

The polo shirts are made up of 35% cotton and 65% polyester. The fabric (known as Protex) is an Australian made fabric specifically engineered to protect against the harmful UV effects of the sun.
