Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2026

Dear Families

Under the *School Education Act 1999* and the *School Education Regulations 2000*, schools are permitted to request financial contributions from parents and caregivers to supplement the school's budget and enhance the learning experiences of all students.

It is important to note that these contributions and charges are **separate** from P&C fundraising activities.

The **West Morley Primary School Board** has reviewed and endorsed the **Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2026** as outlined below.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION

Kindergarten to Year 6 \$60 per child

Each year, parents play a vital role in supporting our school community. One significant way this support is demonstrated is through the payment of the annual voluntary school contributions.

These contributions are essential in helping us maintain and enhance the quality of education we provide. They allow us to resource our existing programs and introduce new initiatives that directly benefit students across all year levels.

Funds raised through voluntary contributions are invested straight back into student learning. This includes additional classroom resources, student activity materials, subject-specific supplies, and IT needs such as our licences to enable compliant management of our devices. Contributions also support our library collection, Digital Technologies, Science equipment, and Physical Education equipment.

We are grateful for the ongoing support of our families. Together, we can continue to enrich our students' educational experiences and create a thriving learning environment for all.

PAYMENTS

If you did not include payment of the \$60 voluntary contribution with your child's personal item list through Campion Education, we kindly ask that you consider making this voluntary contribution, either in full or in part, at any time during the school year.

ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE

ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL CHARGES

The school's voluntary contribution does not cover additional activities that may be offered throughout the year. These optional activities are directly linked to the educational program and are approved by the principal. All students will have the opportunity to participate in a range of enriching experiences as part of their learning.
